Our Disability Confident statement

The **Disability Confident Scheme (DCS)** is a UK government initiative designed to encourage employers to recruit disabled people, and create internal processes to help those who are disabled or with health conditions in the work place.

The DCS is divided into three levels (Disability Confident Committed (level 1), Disability Confident Employer (level 2), and Disability Confident Leader (level 3) and stages, in order to demonstrate the companies commitment and progressive development of support for disabled staff.

We are proud to be a level 2 (**Disability Confident Employer**) member of the scheme, are are vehemently supportive of disabled people in the workplace, and strive to be a positive role model to other companies sector wide.

As part of our commitment to the DCS, we will always make a conscious effort to tailor our job specifications to ensure that all of our opportunities are as disability accessible as they can possibly be.

We will also offer an interview to any disabled candidate who meets the minimum criteria r of the job on paper, and specifies that they wish to participate in the DCS. This will not have any affect on the outcome of the interview.

Finally, we are continuously developing new and innovative ways to support our disabled people, and are aiming to progress to level 3 (Disability Confident Leader) by 2026.
